Standard Operating Procedures



Combi Oven - Cleaning

Report any safety concerns to the supervisor on duty and raise a hazard form



Equipment Required:

-) Combi oven
- Worker to wear footwear that is fully enclosed, slip resistant sole, water repellent/resistant and provides adequate support.
- Personal Protective Equipment required: Gloves, Goggles, PVC apron

Risks & Safety Procedures:

Risk	Safety procedures
Chemical burns to Eyes/Skin from detergent	 Set detergent nozzle to stream (not spray) Range hood on for duration of oven cleaning Wear eye PVC apron, goggles and gloves In case of spills remove all contaminated clothing and wash skin with plenty of water Seek first aid or medical assistance if required.
Burns from Heat/Steam	 Always look away when opening the oven door as the escaping heat can cause serious injury to the eyes. Use a heat resistant glove or cloth to protect hands when removing heated objects If you have a fire in an oven, turn off the oven immediately and unplug the power cord if safe to do so. Do not open the door of the oven, simply wait till the fire suffocates, and never open the door until you are absolutely sure the fire is out. If fire continues Dial Triple Zero (000) and ask for Fire.
Food Contamination	 Ensure that the cooking appliances are clean Food must be cooked at appropriate temperature for appropriate length of time Do not put food into oven until oven has been preheated Gloves must be changed regularly Do not use the same gloves when handling raw foods and cooked.

Safe Working Operation

Process	Worker behaviour	Public/others
Steam Oven	> Turn oven to steam cycle for> 5 minutes	Public to stay away from food preparation areas
Drain Bain Marie	 Place 4 Litre Bucket under tap. Turn on tap and fill ¾ of water. Turn off tap Place Bucket on trolley and wheel over to the waste sink and empty bucket. Repeat until bain is empty 	
Clean Bain Marie	Wipe inside of Bain Marie.Wipe inside over and surrounds	
Follow-up	 Document any incident and report it to your Supervisor immediately
